II. Other Business

Justice Administration

EOG Number: B2008-0613

Problem Statement: The Justice Administrative Commission has a budget shortfall for Fiscal Year 2007-08 in the Criminal Conflict and Dependency Liability appropriation category. This funding was appropriated to pay for legal representation for indigent persons in criminal and certain civil cases appointed prior to July 1, 2007. As of April 4, 2008, a total of \$51,455,204 has been expended. The original appropriation of \$20.4 million as well as an additional appropriation approved by the Legislative Budget Commission (LBC) of \$30 million has been spent. A contingency fund of \$1.5 million in the Justice Administrative Commission has also been transferred to this category through a budget amendment effective April 4, 2008. The Justice Administrative Commission has received bills in excess of these appropriations and is projecting a deficit.

Agency Request: The Justice Administrative Commission requests the transfer of \$9,558,487 in general revenue from the Regional Conflict Counsels operating budget to the Criminal Conflict and Dependency Counsel Liability appropriation category to partially resolve a budget deficit. The Regional Conflict Counsels have a projected surplus due to their delayed implementation. The Justice Administrative Commission also requests a transfer of \$250,000 in General Revenue from the Postconviction Capital Collateral Cases Registry Attorneys category to the Criminal Conflict and Dependency Counsel Liability category. This category is projected to have a surplus.

This additional budget is needed to ensure continued processing of attorney fees and related costs for representation of indigent persons in criminal and certain civil proceedings.

Governor's Recommendation: Recommend approval to transfer \$9,808,487 in General Revenue funds from the Regional Conflict Counsels and from the Postconviction Capital Collateral Cases Registry Attorneys appropriations category to offset a budget shortfall in the Justice Administrative Commission's Criminal Conflict and Dependency Liability appropriation category. Transfer of the identified surplus funds will ensure continued processing of attorney fees and related costs for billings related to representation of indigent persons in criminal and certain civil proceedings prior to July 1, 2007.
