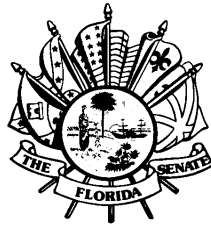

BILLS ON THIRD READING

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [SPCC] GROUPING

SB 992 (3R) by the Committee on Health Regulation (Atwater)—

Health Care Providers Licensure; provides applicability of licensure requirements of health care providers under part II of chapter 408, Florida Statutes. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on March 29, 2007

SB 2876 (3R) by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs (Storms)—

Adoption/Special Needs Children; redefines term "special needs child"; revises provisions re adoption of children with special needs; revises & adds definitions; distinguishes between subsidies & adoption assistance; provides for adoption-assistance agreement. Amends 110.152, 409.166. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Read the second time on March 29, 2007

SB 192 (3R) by Senator Saunders and others—

FGCU/B.S. Degree/Long-term Care; authorizes bachelor of science degree program in long-term care administration at Florida Gulf Coast University. Creates 1004.386. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time and amended on March 29, 2007

CS/SB 246 (3R) by the Committee on Health Regulation, Senator Wise and others—

Cardiac Catheterization Services; revises provisions re compliance with certain criteria imposed on any hospital seeking to provide diagnostic cardiac catheterization Level II services. Amends 408.0361. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on March 29, 2007

CS/SB 650 (3R) by the Committee on Health Regulation and Senator Fasano—

Osteopathic Physicians; revises requirements for licensure or certification as osteopathic physician in this state; requires renewal fee for registering as resident osteopathic physician; requires consideration of intent in order to classify certain actions within practice of osteopathic medicine as misdemeanors; increases penalty for failure to provide certain information re employment of said physicians; repeals provision re licensure by examination, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on March 29, 2007

CS/SB 682 (3R) by the Committee on Health Regulation, Senator Bennett and others—

Nursing Facilities; revises frequency of visits to nursing facilities by quality-of-care monitors from AHCA; authorizes certain licensed nursing facilities to develop plan to provide certain training for nursing assistants; provides for rules re agency approval of training programs; requires that federal posting requirements for staffing standards comply with state posting requirements, etc. Amends 400.118, 141, 147, 19, 195, 23. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time and amended on March 29, 2007

SB 1700 (3R) by Senator Aronberg—

Physician Assistants/Paramedic Cert.; authorizes physician assistants who meet specified criteria to be certified as paramedics. Amends 401.27. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Read the second time on March 29, 2007

SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [EPCC] GROUPING

SB 210 (2R) by Senator Lynn—

Habitual Traffic Offenders; exempts persons convicted under specified provisions of driving with canceled, suspended, or revoked driver's license from being designated as habitual traffic offender after three convictions. Amends 322.264. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Transportation and Criminal Justice

SB 1748 (2R) by Senator Gaetz and others—

Insurance Contracts/Workers' Comp.; prohibits rejection of workers' compensation insurance policies issued by certain self-insurance funds under certain circumstances. Creates 627.442. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Banking and Insurance, and Regulated Industries

FISCAL POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [FPCC] GROUPING

SB 1420 (2R) by Senator Carlton—

Employee Benefits; provides for resolution of certain collective bargaining issues at impasse between State of Florida & certified bargaining units of state employees. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably by the Committee on General Government Appropriations

SB 1422 (2R) by Senator Carlton—

Employee Health Savings Accounts; specifies amount of employer contribution to employee health savings accounts for 2007-2008 fiscal year. Amends 110.123. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committee on General Government Appropriations

**LAW AND JUSTICE POLICY AND
CALENDAR COMMITTEE [LPCC] GROUPING**

CS/SB 116 (2R) by the Committee on Commerce and Senator Atwater—

Armed Forces Member/Use of Name; prohibits person from using name or image of member of armed forces; provides exceptions; defines term "member of armed forces"; provides criminal penalties. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Commerce

CS/SB 154 (2R) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Geller—

Parent-child Privilege; creates parent-child privilege to prevent disclosure of communications that were intended to be made in confidence; prescribes proceedings in which privilege does not exist; provides for waiver of privilege; requires that guardian ad litem be appointed to represent minor child prior to court's approving child's waiver of privilege. Creates 90.5045. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary and the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, reports the committee substitute favorably

CS/CS/SB 156 (2R) by the Committees on Governmental Operations, Military Affairs and Domestic Security and Senator Geller—

Veterans Defined/Wartime Service; redefines term "veteran" for purposes of construing Florida Statutes to include person who served in active military, naval, or air service in Operation Enduring Freedom or Operation Iraqi Freedom. Amends 1.01. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Operations

CS/SB 174 (2R) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator Geller—

Practice of Law; deletes provisions & exception to provision prohibiting sheriff, deputy sheriff, clerk, or deputy clerk from practicing law. Amends 454.18. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary and the Committee on Criminal Justice reports the committee substitute favorably

CS/SB 184 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice, Senator Dockery and others—

Strangulation/Domestic Battery; provides that it is third-degree felony to knowingly and intentionally impede normal breathing or circulation of blood of another person in specified ways; provides exception & definitions; provides criminal penalties; amends provision re offense severity ranking chart of Criminal Punishment Code; conforms reference to changes made by act. Amends 784.041, 921.0022. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice and the Committee on Health Regulation reports the committee substitute favorably and withdrawn from the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

CS/SB 412 (2R) by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security and Senator Baker—

Education/Children of POWs or MIAs; expands provision of educational opportunity at state expense for children of service members, or civilian personnel captured while serving with consent or authorization of United States Government, who are classified as prisoners of war or missing in action. Amends 295.015. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and withdrawn from the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations

SB 472 (2R) by Senator Baker and others—

Law Enforcement Personnel/Employment; revises presumption of disability for certain law enforcement, correctional, & correctional probation officers; authorizes agency that employs law enforcement personnel to establish tobacco-use standards. Amends 943.13,.137. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Criminal Justice and Governmental Operations and withdrawn from the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

CS/SB 728 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations, Senator Fasano and others—

Veteran's Employment Preference; repeals provision re expiration of veteran's preference in public employment after one application; deletes reference to repealed statute. Repeals 295.101; amends 110.2135. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Operations

CS/SB 816 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and the Committee on Criminal Justice—

OGSR/Public Records Requests/Law Enf. Agencies; amends provision re requests for public records by law enforcement agencies; clarifies that exemption applies during period that information identifying public-records request constitutes active criminal intelligence information; saves exemption from repeal under OGSR Act; deletes provisions that provide for repeal of exemption. Amends 119.071. Effective Date: 10/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Operations

SM 1698 (2R) by Senator Margolis and others—

People of Darfur/Peace; urges Congress, with support of President, to engage international community to take action in effort to bring just & lasting peace to people of Darfur.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security

RESPONSIBLE REGULATION POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [RPCC] GROUPING

CS/SB 464 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Operations and Senator Siplin—

Three Kings Day/January 6; designates January 6 as "Three Kings Day" & authorizes local governments to issue proclamations commemorating occasion. Creates 683.33. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Operations

CS/SB 656 (2R) by the Committee on Community Affairs, Senator Rich and others—

Local Business Taxes; authorizes certain municipalities to reclassify businesses & occupations & establish new business tax rates before specified date; provides that specified provisions do not prohibit municipality or county from decreasing or repealing local business tax. Amends 205.0535. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs and the Committees on Commerce and Finance and Tax, report the committee substitute favorably

CS/SB 1178 (2R) by the Committee on Community Affairs, Senator Rich and others—

Local Business Tax Receipts; revises date for beginning annual sale of local business tax receipts. Amends 205.053. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs and the Committees on Commerce and Finance and Tax, report the committee substitute favorably

SR 1860 (2R) by Senator Bennett—

Renewable Energy/Agriculture; supports vision of "25 by '25," & encourages production of renewable energy & fuels by farms & ranches to help meet future energy needs.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Agriculture

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [SPCC] GROUPING

SB 2 (2R) by Senator Dawson and others—

Unattended Child in Motor Vehicle; provides that offense of leaving child unattended or unsupervised in motor vehicle constitutes second-degree misdemeanor rather than noncriminal traffic infraction; provides that such offense is third-degree felony if child suffers great bodily harm, disability, or disfigurement; provides penalties. Amends 316.6135. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably by the Committees on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, and Criminal Justice

FIRST PUBLICATION ON SECOND READING

SB 2800 (2R) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy and Calendar Committee—

Appropriations; provides moneys for annual period beginning July 1, 2007, & ending June 30, 2008; pays salaries, & other expenses, capital outlay - buildings, & other improvements, & for other specified purposes of various agencies of State government. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 or upon becoming law, whichever occurs later, except as otherwise provided.

SB 2802 (2R) by the Committee on Fiscal Policy and Calendar Committee—

Appropriations Implementing Bill; provides for use of specified calculations re Fla. Education Finance Program; requires that funds appropriated for forensic mental health treatment services be allocated to areas of state having greatest demand for services & treatment capacity; requires DCFS to ensure that certain information re child welfare cases is entered into Fla. Safe Families Network; authorizes use of state aircraft for commuting, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 06/30/2007 except as otherwise provided.

FISCAL POLICY AND CALENDAR COMMITTEE [FPCC] GROUPING

CS/SB 1046 (2R) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations and Senator Wise—

Pre-K Through Grade 12 Education; provides that certain funds transferred to Educ. Enhancement TF may be used for recurring appropriations; clarifies that term "exceptional student" for purposes of specified provision includes gifted students in grades K through 8; defines terms "team teaching," "co-teaching," & "inclusion teaching" for purposes of provisions authorizing use of various teaching strategies in order to implement requirements for class-size reduction, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations

CS/SB 1052 (2R) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations and Senator Wise—

Florida Prepaid Tuition Scholarship Endowment; creates endowment within State Board of Administration for purpose of funding scholarships for economically disadvantaged youth; provides for moneys from tax on slot machines to be transferred from Educational Enhancement TF to endowment as provided in General Appropriations Act; provides for revenues of endowment to be appropriated to direct-support organization of Fla. Prepaid College Board, etc. Creates 215.5605. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations

CS/SB 1058 (2R) by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations and Senator Wise—

Appropriations Implementing Bill; provides legislative intent; provides for use of specified calculations re Fla. Education Finance Program; provides finding that authorization & issuance of certain debt is in best interest of state; provides for effect of veto of specific appropriation or proviso to which implementing language refers; provides for continued operation of certain provisions notwithstanding future repeal or expiration provided by act, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations

CS/SB 1060 (2R) by the Committee on Education Facilities Appropriations and Senator King—

Educational Facilities; deletes provisions re distribution of proceeds from excise tax on documents to Public Education Capital Outlay & Debt Service TF; revises date by which distribution company must remit taxes on gross receipts from sale of utility services; prescribes life to be used for certain facilities in calculating distributions from such trust fund; clarifies those K-12 students on whose behalf distributions will be made from such trust fund, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Facilities Appropriations

CS/SB 1064 (2R) by the Committee on Education Facilities Appropriations and Senator King—

Facility Enhancement Challenge Grant Programs; amends specified provision re Community College Facility Enhancement Challenge Grant Program; requires that project be approved by State Board of Education or Legislature; requires that unexpended private matching funds revert to direct-support organization capital facilities matching account of community college; provides for future termination of Alec P. Courtelis Capital Facilities Matching Trust Fund, etc. Amends 1011.32, 1013.79. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Education Facilities Appropriations

CS/SB 1086 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations and Senator Crist—

Capital Collateral Regional Counsel; deletes provisions providing for pilot program in northern region of state to operate capital collateral regional counsel office. Amends 27.701. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

CS/SB 1088 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations and Senator Crist—

Due Process; provides for offices of criminal conflict & civil regional counsel to be appointed to represent persons in certain cases in which public defender is unable to provide representation; provides for private counsel to be appointed only when public defender & regional counsel are unable to provide representation; creates office of criminal conflict & civil regional counsel within boundaries of each of five district courts of appeal, etc. Amends FS. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

CS/SB 1094 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations and Senator Crist—

Implementing General Appropriations Act; authorizes DOC & DJJ to make certain expenditures to defray costs incurred by municipality or county as result of opening or operating facility under authority of respective dept.; provides for additional positions to operate additional prison bed capacity under certain circumstances; authorizes Legal Affairs Dept. to expend appropriated funds on programs funded in preceding fiscal year, etc. Amends 216.262, .292, 932.7055. Effective Date: 07/01/2007 except as otherwise provided.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations

CS/SB 1100 (2R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Alexander—

Securities Transactions Regulation; increases registration & filing fees for dealers & investment advisers who deal or trade in securities; increases fees imposed for making or renewing notice filing; repeals provisions re allocation & disbursement of assessment fees & Investment Fraud Restoration Financing Corp.; revises formula for transferring revenues received as assessment fees into Securities Guaranty Fund, etc. Amends 517.12, .1201, .131, .315; repeals 517.1203, .1204. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on General Government Appropriations

CS/SB 1104 (2R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Alexander—

Vessels/Registration Fee; imposes additional surcharge on vessel registration fee to be deposited into Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund within FWC; authorizes commission to retain percentage of funds to cover certain costs of grant program; requires that program for removal of derelict vessels established by commission be funded in part from Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund. Amends 328.72, 376.15. Effective Date: 07/01/2007.

Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on General Government Appropriations

CS/SB 1110 (2R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Alexander—

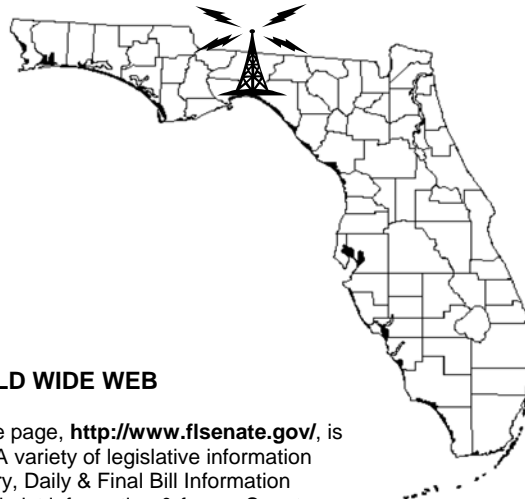
