Lottery Games; Requiring the Department of the Lottery to include a specified warning in advertisements or promotions of lottery games; providing requirements for such warning; requiring contracts between the department and a vendor to include a provision that requires the vendor to place or print a specified warning on all lottery tickets, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2019.

GENERAL BILL by State Affairs Committee; Local, Federal & Veterans Affairs Subcommittee; Overdorf; (CO-SPONSORS) Clemons (Similar CS/SB 816, Compare CS/HB 603)

Environmental Regulation; Requires counties & municipalities to address contamination of recyclable material in specified contracts; prohibits counties & municipalities from requiring collection or transport of contaminated recyclable material by residential recycling collectors; specifies required contract provisions; prohibits local governments from requiring certain project verification from DEP; revises types of dock & pier replacements & repairs that are exempt from verification & certain permitting requirements; prohibits local government entities from adopting or enforcing ordinances & regulations relating to single-use plastic straws; provides for lift of moratorium. Effective Date: 07/01/2019.
