Effective Date: Upon becoming a law.

Relief of Clemente Aguirre-Jarquín by the State of Florida; Providing for the relief of Clemente Aguirre-Jarquín for his wrongful incarceration; providing an appropriation to the Department of Financial Services for a specified purpose; directing the Chief Financial Officer to draw a warrant for the purchase of an annuity contract in a specified amount in Mr. Aguirre-Jarquín's name within a specified timeframe; providing for the waiver of certain tuition and fees for Mr. Aguirre-Jarquín, subject to specified requirements; providing a limitation on the payment of compensation, etc. Claim with appropriation: \$720,000. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law.

Relief of Christeia Jones by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; Providing for the relief of Christeia Jones, as guardian of Logan Grant, Denard Maybin, Jr., and Lanard Maybin; providing an appropriation to compensate them for injuries and damages sustained as a result of an automobile accident caused by Trooper Raul Umama, an employee of the Florida Highway Patrol, a division of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; providing a limitation on the payment of attorney fees, etc. Claim with appropriation: \$17,715,000. Effective Date: 07/01/2021.

Relief of Barney Brown by the State of Florida; Providing for the relief of Barney Brown, who was wrongfully incarcerated for 38 years; providing an appropriation to compensate him for his wrongful incarceration; providing that the act does not waive certain defenses or increase the state's liability; providing that the appropriation satisfies all present and future claims related to the arrest, conviction, and incarceration of Mr. Brown; prohibiting the award of any additional amounts for specified purposes, etc. Claim with appropriation: \$1,900,000. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law.

Relief of Former Employees of Fairfax Street Wood Treaters by the State of Florida; Providing for the relief of former employees of Fairfax Street Wood Treaters; directing the Department of Health to collaborate with the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health to develop specified data for certain purposes; providing an appropriation to compensate the former employees for injuries and damages sustained as a result of the negligence of the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Financial Services, and the Department of Health, etc. Claim with appropriation: \$10,000,000. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law.
