GENERAL BILL by Rules; Community Affairs; Perry (Compare CS/CS/CS/HB 203, CS/CS/CS/HB 395 (1ST ENG), CS/HB 519 (1ST ENG), HB 7099, CS/SB 1398, CS/SB 1766, CS/SB 7018 (1ST ENG), SB 7054)

Growth Management: Prohibiting counties from adopting, after a specified date, a comprehensive plan, a land development regulation, or another form of restriction unless certain conditions are met; prohibiting a municipality from annexing specified areas under certain circumstances; requiring the Department of Economic Opportunity to give a preference to certain counties and municipalities when selecting applications for funding for specified technical assistance; requiring local governments to include a property rights element in their comprehensive plans, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2020.

GENERAL BILL by Appropriations; Innovation, Industry and Technology; Health Policy; Simmons; (CO-INTRODUCERS) Flores; Mayfield (Linked CS/CS/SB 1394 (1ST ENG), Compare HB 151, CS/HB 7089, SB 694, SB 1638)

Use of Tobacco Products and Nicotine Products: Requiring permits to be issued to persons or corporations whose officers are not less than 21 years of age; specifying that fees for a retail tobacco products dealer permit only apply to retailers dealing in certain tobacco products; revising prohibitions on the sale of tobacco products from vending machines; prohibiting a person from selling, delivering, bartering, furnishing, or giving flavored liquid nicotine products to any other person, etc. Effective Date: 01/01/2021.

**PUBLIC RECORDS/GENERAL BILL by Perry (Linked CS/CS/SB 700
(1ST ENG), Identical HB 1173, Compare HB 615)**

Public Records/Nonjudicial Arrest Record of a Minor; Providing an exemption from public records requirements for a nonjudicial record of the arrest of a minor who has successfully completed a diversion program; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: On the same date that SB 700 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
