# FLORIDA LEGISLATURE 2022A - SPECIAL SESSION HISTORY OF SENATE BILLS

## SB 2-A

### GENERAL BILL by Boyd (Identical HB 1-A)

Property Insurance: Creating the Florida Optional Reinsurance Assistance program (FORA), to be administered by the State Board of Administration; authorizing eligible insurers to purchase reinsurance coverage under FORA; providing that property insurers may be subject to an additional market conduct examination by the Office of Insurance Regulation after a hurricane under certain circumstances; specifying conditions that must be met for a property insurance policy to require mandatory binding arbitration; prohibiting policyholders from assigning post-loss insurance benefits under residential or commercial property insurance policies issued on or after a specified date, etc. Appropriation: \$1,757,982. Effective Date: 12/16/2022 Except as otherwise expressly provided.

### GENERAL BILL by Hutson (Similar HB 3-A)

Disaster Relief: Authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to waive or reduce match requirements for certain local governments; authorizing the refund of ad valorem taxes for residential improvements rendered uninhabitable by certain hurricanes; providing for the extension and suspension of payments and discounts of certain taxes and assessments; requiring the Division of Emergency Management and local governments to enter into certain agreements to receive specified funds; providing for the organization and operation of the Florida Emergency Management Assistance Foundation within the division, etc. Appropriation: \$751,500,000. Effective Date: 12/16/2022.

### GENERAL BILL by DiCeglie (Identical HB 5-A)

Toll Relief: Requiring the Florida Turnpike Enterprise to establish a toll relief program for a specified timeframe; specifying the requirements for eligibility for account credits under the program; authorizing the department to reimburse each Florida toll facility or Florida toll facility entity for the actual account credits issued, based on specified reports; requiring each Florida toll facility or Florida toll facility entity to submit certain documentation for reimbursement, etc. Appropriation: \$500,000,000. Effective Date: 12/15/2022.
