GENERAL BILL by State Affairs Committee; Overdorf (Linked CS/HJR 1-F, Identical CS/SB 4-F)

Property Tax Administration; Revises limitations on maximum millage rate that may be levied by certain units of government; conforms provision to changes made by act; authorizes ballot summary of specified proposed amendment or revision of State Constitution to exceed specified word limit; provides for construction of act in pari materia with laws enacted during 2026 Regular Session & 2026 Special Session E of Legislature. Effective Date: upon becoming a law.
