Casey Anthony may still face death penalty

ORLANDO, Fla. (AP) -- A Florida judge has denied a request to take the death penalty off the table in the prosecution of a mother charged with killing her 2-year-old daughter.

The judge ruled Friday that prosecutors can ask a jury to consider the death penalty during Casey Anthony's trial next year.

Anthony's attorneys had argued that prosecutors were seeking the death penalty in bad faith.

Anthony is charged with first-degree murder in the death of her daughter, Caylee. She has pleaded not guilty.
